Crankcase Quantity When operating your 12.5 HP engine at temperatures above 40 degrees Fahrenheit, Briggs & Stratton calls for 48 fluid ounces (1.5 quarts) of SAE 30 weight detergent motor oil approved for four-cycle engine service levels SF-SJ or higher. Your owner's manual will tell you the exact grade required, but in almost all cases 10W30 is the right stuff for a four-stroke engines. Any brand of oil that's suitable for cars or trucks will work fine in your mower. Is all SAE 30 oil the same? SAE30 weight oil is rated only at the full operating temp of the engine. This means it is much higher than 30 when cold. However it is important to note that the 30 is the same across all three oils, meaning that they will all be the same viscosity once the engine is at full operating temperature. What does 10W30 mean? For Example: 10W30 This means the viscosity is at 10W when the engine is cold and 30 when the engine is hot. Low viscosities are good for cold temperatures (hence the "W" association) because the oil is thinner. Thinner motor oil flows more easily and moves quickly. How do you tell if a lawn mower is 2 stroke or 4 stroke? To know if your lawn mower is a 2 stroke or a 4 stroke, it's very simple: just open your eyes and check the number and type of filling ports.
